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
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INTRODUCTION

I - BIBLIOLOGY

Bibliology is the part of theology study analyzing the Bible as a collection of sacred books, since its formation, inspiration, structure, and history. The Bible was written on papyrus (common plant leaves in Egypt) and parchment (animal hide working for writing), these rolls are also called scripts. Currently there are about 40,000 manuscripts prepared between the second century and the XV.

1 - The first translations

The first translation of the Old Testament into another language (Greek) was called "Septuagint" because there were seventy experts who translated (ie the biblical inter period) from Hebrew into Greek. The first complete translation into another language (Latin) was called "Vulgate" (ie in the year 400 A.D.). Because it was translated into Vulgar Latin. The word "Bible" comes from the Greek word "biblos" which means "little books."

The first translation into English was in the Middle Ages by order of King James and so was called "King James Version".

At the time of Reform (XVI century), Luther translated into German and was in 1569 that published the complete translation of the Bible into Spanish. It's the famous translation "Casiodo Reina." Today the Bible is translated into more than 1,500 languages, thanks to the work of missionaries who have dedicated their lives to forward other people the word of God; Bible societies also greatly contributed to the dissemination of the Bible. Did you know that since the invention of the press today published the book most in the world is the Bible?

Two enemies of the Bible, who tried to prevent their disclosure were:

- A The Greek king Antiochus Epiphanes (second century BC) who tried to destroy the A.T. Ordering it to be burned all the Bibles.
- B The Roman Catholic Church during the Middle Ages that forbade people to read the Bible and even killed thousands of Protestants for spreading the word of God.

2 - Structure of the Bible

The Bible has two divisions: the Old and New Testament. first we will see the order of the Old Testament and the approximate date they were written:

The Old Testament

A – Law

Genesis (1490 BC), Exodus (1490 BC), Lev (1490 BC), Numbers (1450 BC) and Deuteronomy (1450 BC).

B – Historical

Joshua (1427 BC), Judges (1100 BC), Ruth (1180 BC), Samuel (1056 BC), Il Samuel 1000 BC), I Kings (897 BC), Il Kings (588 BC), I Chronicles 457 BC) Il Chronicles (457 BC), Ezra (457 BC), Nehemiah (465 BC) Ester (465 BC).

C - Poetic

Job (1490 BC) Psalms (from the tenth century and VI a. C.), Proverbs (970 BC), Ecclesiastes (970 BC) and Song (970 BC).

D - Major Prophets

Isaiah (698 BC), Jeremiah (585 BC), Lamentations (585 BC), Ezekiel (574 BC) and Daniel (534 BC).

E - Minor Prophets

Hosea (785 BC), Joel (800 BC), Amos (787 BC), Obadiah (587 BC), Jonas (852 BC), Micah (710 BC), Nahum (713 BC), Habakkuk (626 BC), Zephaniah (630 BC) Haggai (510 BCE), Zechariah (487 BC), Malachi (397 BC)

The Old Testament was written in Hebrew and small portions in Aramaic. The period in which all it took was written 1100 years, from Moses to Malachi. The Old Testament is the sacred book of the Jews. Another structure of the Old Testament is: Law, Prophets (major and minor prophets) and Writings (historical and poetical books).



New Testament



Jerusalem, the main city mentioned in the Bible.

The New Testament is divided into:

A - Biographical (in the strict sense: the Gospels): Matthew (60 A.D.), Mark (57 A.D.), Luke (A.D. 60) and John (90 A.D.).

B – History Acts (66 A.D.)

C - Ecclesiastical Letters

Romans (57 AD), I Corinthians (AD 54), II Corinthians (AD 55), Gal (53 AD), Ephesians (60 AD), Phil (61 AD), Col. (61 AD), I Thessalonians (AD 51) II Thessalonians (52 AD).

D - Individual Letters (pastoral)
I Timothy (A.D. 64), Timothy (67 A.D.), Titus (A.D. 65), and Philemon (60 A.D.)

E - Collective Letter Hebrews (68 A.D.)

F - Universal Letters -

James (50 A.D.), I Peter (A.D. 65), Peter II (66 A.D.), I John (90 A.D.), John II (A.D. 90), John III (A.D. 90) and Judas (A.D. 66)

G – Prophetic Revelation (96 A.D.)

The New Testament was written in Greek in the space of 60 years. The first part of the Bible recognized as sacred was the law, some centuries after the other Old

Testament books were gathered together in one volume is also considered sacred; since the New Testament books were only considered definitely canonical (sacred) about 300 years after Christ (it is important to us to say that whenever a book was written, was automatically recognized sacred by the people of God community).

Millennium - Armageddon the Final Battle (Revelation 20.1-7).

The Bible even if not a scientific book, makes some revelations that men could only prove these last centuries, it also contains prophecies that were loyal greetings. The following will examine a list of them:

- G Destruction of the Temple (Matthew 24.1-2) (70 DC.).
- H The slaughter of the Jews (Luke 19.41-44) (70DC).
 - I The atom (Hebrews 11.3) (1900).
 - J AIDS (Romans 1:27; Rev. 2.21-23.).
 - L Israel Foundation (Isaiah 66.8) (14 May 1948).

5 – Inspiration

The Bible is inspired by God!!!!! Many people do not understand the origin of the Bible and say, "how can God have written the Bible?" - But we do not say that God wrote the Bible, however, faithful and loyal men of God were inspired and guided by the Spirit of the Lord to write the Bible. Memorize it well: It was not psychographic, not dictated, but inspired. God guided the thinking and words that men wrote. The Bible itself declares written by men under special inspiration of God (Exodus 24.4 Jeremiah 30.2: Isaiah 34:16: 8.1; 2.2 Habakkuk and Zechariah 7:12).

In the Bible appears the phrase "God said" or "thus said the Lord," and others like these about 2,600 times, this means that there is strong internal evidence pointing to the Bible the word of God (Psalm 62.11; Isaiah 45.5; Mat 3:17;. II Corinthians 4.6; Apoc 1.17-18;. Gen. 1:28;. Exodus 20.1-3; Joshua 1.1; Judges 6:23; I Samuel 3:10, Job 42.7).
